

Autumn 2015 Young People's Photo Competition - RULES AND ENTRY FORM

1. Entry is open to young people resident or attending school or college in Abingdon-on-Thames from September 2015.
2. There are three age categories for entries
 - Primary School (age 7-11 yrs.)
 - Secondary School (age 12-16 yrs.)
 - Sixth Form and College (from 17 up to and including 20 years of age)

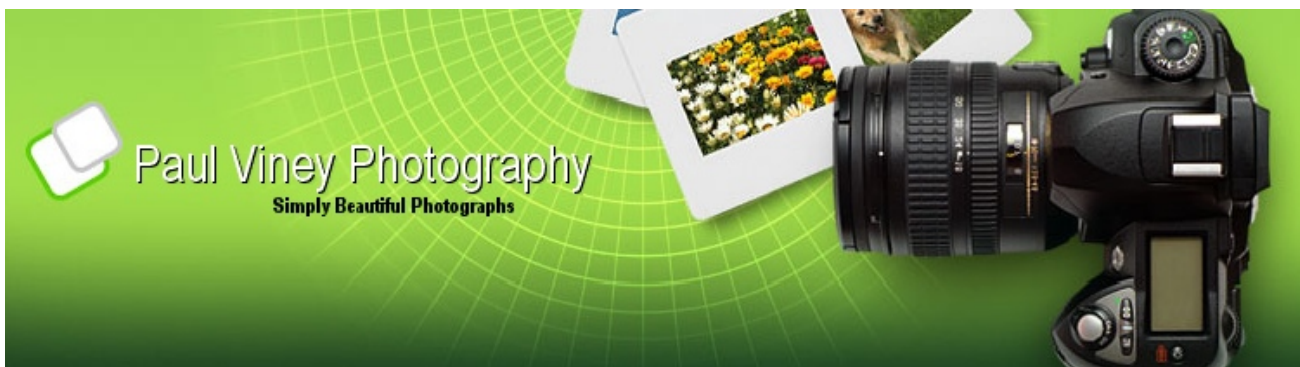
Note: For entrants under 16 years of age, parental consent to enter will be required.
3. There will be three prizes in each category
 - 1st prize £50
 - 2nd prize £30
 - 3rd prize £15
4. The topic is "*The natural world around us*", for example:
 - One to three photos showing nature, e.g. seasonal changes, or atmospheric shots of trees or water
 - Photos of wildlife (not family pets)

Entrants are encouraged to be as creative as possible within the topic and to use the title as a source of inspiration.
5. When entering, please:
 - indicate which topic each picture is entered for (e.g. Wildlife, The Seasons, Water etc.)
 - enclose a copy of the consent form if people are used as subjects, *entries cannot be considered without appropriate consent*
 - attach an entry form with each photograph or set of 2 or 3 photos submitted
6. Submissions should be made by 30th November 2015, to S Vaughan c/o Newlus Ltd, Abingdon Business Centre, 7 Nuffield Way, Abingdon, OX14 1RL
7. Only printed photographs on photographic paper will be accepted
 - Photos may be any shape or size.
 - Cropped details are acceptable.
8. A maximum of 3 entries per person will be permitted
9. Entrants assign full copyright and authority to license and publish the photographs offered in this competition, for use by The Rotary Club of Abingdon Vesper only
10. By entering the competition, entrants agree to the use of their work in whole or cropped by The Rotary Club of Abingdon Vesper in perpetuity, unless permission is withdrawn in writing at a later date, and this request is acknowledged. Other entries may also be displayed subject to available space, and entrants will be notified accordingly. A digital version of the photograph will be requested for display on the website.
